Harmari Contractor Report Case Study: Louisiana

Unlicensed contractors operating in any jurisdiction poses a challenge for any contractor licensing board. With budget-consciousness in mind, a delicate balance exists between putting the hammer down and gentle guidance in the right direction. Below is a positive example of how the Harmari Contractor Report helped the Louisiana State Licensing Board for Contractors generate a small, but noticeable impact with a low cost, efficient email marketing campaign within Craigslist advertisers.

The case study starts with a snapshot of the Contractor Report, zoomed in on a cluster of ads from the same contractor (identified by phone number) offering electrical services. Notice the column highlighted in red which is where the license information is supposed to be entered for the ad. One subtle difference in the licensing of the ad circled in red is that a license number is indicated where in the previous ads, the only claim was that the contractor was licensed in the state.



LSLBC uses this Harmari Contractor Report to efficiently email any unlicensed contractors advertising on Craigslist stating that a license is required if they engage in contracting work within Louisiana above \$1500 per project. Now below left is a recent license check on the LSLBC Website.



The license was *first issued* on May 31, 2012 even though the business *claimed* to be licensed in their ad above as early as March 31, 2012. In fact, out of 81 unique contracting firms that advertised on Craigslist from November 1, 2011 to August 1, 2012, **17 new firms** were licensed. The graph on the right illustrates the point: a 21% increase in licensees over the course of the study, which indicates that the email campaign worked!
